The Role

Job Purpose

- To manage ERM project implementation with local partners in Kachin and Northern Shan State in Myanmar, ensuring its relevance to the local context and compliance with internal and external quality standards.
- To lead delivery of ERM grants to local partners in agreed protocol and timeline. This role will
 play to maintain/build good relationship and coordination mechanism with local partners
 including capacity building initiatives to ensure project delivers the qualitative
 outputs/outcomes in line with effective accountability systems to partner projects.



Our role will require a range of skills and experience.

Job Requirements

Essential

- University degree in relevant fields (social science, development, management, etc)
- At least 3 years proven experience of managing development and/or disaster management programme.
- Proven experience in financial management and grant management
- Demonstrated commitment to humanitarian principles of humanity, neutrality, impartiality and independence
- Proven experience in programming work at grassroots level, especially experience in application of participatory approaches.
- Demonstrated facilitation/training skills
- Experience in identifying training needs and facilities training programmes
- Proven experience and ability to work with partners
- Good understanding and practical experience in application of equity issues (Gender and diversity)
- Ability to prioritise, problem-solved and meet agreed deadlines
- Ability to communicate effectively and to play an active internal and external influencing role
- Proven skills to work with others within teams and across teams and partners as well
- Strong written and spoken English and Myanmar
- Computer literacy and skills in Microsoft programmes such as Word, Excel, PowerPoint
- Willingness to travel (50% of total time) to project areas (especially Kachin State and Yangon)
- Willingness to work flexible hours

Desirable

- Strong experiences in humanitarian response works (Conflict & disaster)
- Experience and knowledge of emergency grant management/partner contracts/agreements
- Strong finance and operation background.
- A good understanding of the humanitarian context in Kachin and Northern Shan State.
- Strong experience in working with partnership and localization agenda.
- Experience and understanding of working within SPHERE, CoC, humanitarian principle, NGO/Red Cross Code of Conduct and accountability frameworks like HAP.
