## **KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:**

## **Overall Country MEAL Management (40%)**

- Manage the MEAL team in leading the planning and implementation of monitoring, evaluation, accountability and learning for all projects, to enhance the quality of the work and that Oxfam's minimum standards are met or exceeded.
- Provide technical guidance, coaching and mentoring to Senior MEAL Officers (both regular data collection, outcome monitoring, analysis and presentation/utilisation of data) as well as supporting their abilities to facilitate learning processes and workshops
- Ensure MEAL work follows a systematic approach that supports identifying, capturing, sharing, applying and creating knowledge, analysing and documenting how change is happening within programmes, as well as making knowledge accessible and usable for intended partner organizations and Oxfam
- Develop and conduct capacity building for MEAL, program staff and partner staff, with the support from the Programme Quality Manager.
- o Participate in project design processes and develop MEAL frameworks and approaches for new projects
- Review and feedback on all baseline, midterm, end line and evaluation reports developed by senior MEAL
  officers and external consultants.
- Regularly review, assess and improve MEAL tools and processes to ensure greatest effectiveness, efficiencies and compliance with donor requirements
- o Ensure adherence to the implementation of MEAL activity plans across all projects
- Ensure differences due to gender is integrated into all MEL Frameworks to measure the difference between women, girls, boys and men.
- Staff management and mentoring of Oxfam's MEAL team
- o Develop and implement organisation-wide Accountability to beneficiaries mechanisms

- Responsible for leading Oxfam's annual global output reporting for the Myanmar office, aggregating beneficiary data from all Oxfam's projects
- Be an active member of the Programme Quality Team, acting as Programme Quality Manager when required

## **Humanitarian respond and Resilience (60%)**

- Together with programme staff, lead the design of MEAL frameworks and action plans for 2 -3 humanitarian and resilience projects
- Work with project managers and partners of 2-3 humanitarian and resilience projects to ensure the implementation of effective Monitoring, accountability and learning.
- Design and implement KAPs/baseline/mid-term/end line, Post Distribution Monitoring, other surveys and evaluations as required
- Detailed Data Analysis, interpretation, triangulation, visualization, dissemination (graphs), presentation and reporting for humanitarian and resilience projects.
- Work with project staff and partners to develop regular monitoring processes including establishing beneficiary databases
- o Conduct regular physical project monitoring of 2 -3 projects
- Perform data quality assessment to verify the quality of reported data for key indicators and the ability of data management systems.
- Implement a mechanism for accountability to beneficiaries and monitor the mechanism is functioning within projects.
- MEAL support to partners and staff, ensuring MEAL data is translated into clear information that can be used to inform decision making

- Demonstrated commitment to using documentation and MEAL to learn from programmes, and applying this to improving Oxfam's overall impact.
- Strong knowledge and understanding of MEAL management and leadership at a strategic level
- Education to at least degree level in social sciences, statistics, international development, mathematics, international relations or other relevant field.
- Minimum of 3 years' experience in a senior level of Monitoring, Evaluation, Accountability and Learning Mechanism.
- Demonstrated monitoring and evaluation technical skills, including developing MEAL frameworks, designing and undertaking data collection processes, Analysing qualitative and quantitative data, and reporting.
- Strong technical understanding of quantitative, qualitative and mixed methods
- Strong knowledge of ICT4D and familiarity with associated web-based platforms and applications
- o Experience in establishing community feedback mechanisms
- o Strong facilitation skills and experience in building capacity of varied stakeholders
- Experience in working in multi-sectoral programmes and ability to manage multiple priorities, work under pressure and deadlines.
